The purpose of this report is to provide a monthly performance briefing on the Transport Enforcement Unit (TEU).

The Transport Enforcement Unit (TEU), currently situated within Safety and Security's Traffic Services, focuses on the following functions:

- Public transport safety and security,
 - focus on crime such as arrests for drug dealing at PTI's, prevention of robberies on MyCiti & NMT Routes as well as focusing on Bylaw Contraventions, inclusive of vagrancy
- Public transport traffic enforcement,
 - issuing notices for NRTA, NLTA and Traffic Bylaw infringements
- Public transport regulations
 - impounding taxis for operating illegally or, operating contrary to their operating licences
- Revenue protection
 - focus on issues of fair evasion on MyCiti

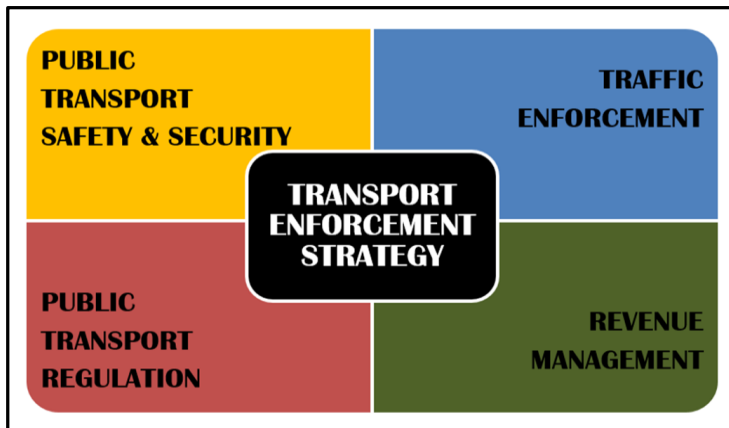
