## PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION DETAIL AT SUBCOUNCIL AND WARD LEVEL

## EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT (ECD) PROGRAMME

One of the key long-term interventions of the City is an investment in ECD. SD&ECD provides support and capacity building for ECD facilities so that they can be registered with the provincial government of the Western Cape (PGWC).

## a) ECD Assessment in Informal Settlements

Number of assessments/recommendations to Early Childhood Development Centres (ECDs) in informal settlements to assist them to become compliant.

The aim of the visits to the ECD's is to complete assessments/ recommendation forms and refer non-compliant ECD's to the relevant Departments for further engagements as well as develop an intervention plan to address the needs of the ECD Centres.

Different training interventions were identified to assist and equip the operators with basic knowledge and skills in order to become compliant.
