

14SUB10/1/2017 UPGRADE NYANGA MAIN TAXI RANK – C11.10540

Francois van Niekerk reported as follows:

TDA embarked on the development phase of the Orio Project and that it was funded by the Dutch Government. Application was made for funding to implement the project. This process has been on-going for the past year and due to the lack/insufficient funds the project ceased until further notice and therefore the External Grant Funding (Dutch Government) has been removed from the PCER.

Francois van Niekerk, however, stated that even though the project is complexed, the continuation of the project is still considered. Once the legal matters have been concluded, the intention is to re-introduced the project to the budget.

Cllr Yozi expressed his concerns regarding the prioritization of upgrading the Nyanga Main Taxi Rank. He made mentioned of other Taxi Ranks that received funding and is now completed. In addition, he asked whether timeframes are in place for the Nyanga Taxi Rank.

Francois van Niekerk responded and said that the Upgrade of the Main Nyanga Taxi Rank will be included in the Draft Budget and attempts will be made to source funding from the Public Transport Network Grant (PTNG) (National Government). He further said that the Integrated Rapid Transport System (IRTS) will also be rolled out in Nyanga and therefore it is key that the Upgrade of the Nyanga Main Taxi Rank be included in the Draft Budget.

Cllr Makasi displayed the same sentiments of Cllr Yozi and said that feedback must be provided to the Subcouncil. She said that the communities were informed of the project and an expectation has been created in terms of economic development opportunities.

It was agreed that the Project: Upgrade Nyanga Main Taxi Rank remain on the MRA and that further feedback be obtained with regard to previous submissions that were made to the Subcouncil.

RESOLVED

That the Upgrade: Nyanga Main Taxi Rank REMAIN on the MRA as an outstanding item.
