### 3. PURPOSE

To report on an application for a liquor license received in terms of SECTION 66(2) REMOVALS of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008, as amended by the Western Cape Liquor Amendment Act, 2010 and Western Cape Liquor Regulations, 2011 and to inform the Subcouncil of the outcome of public participation conducted on the application and recommendation submitted to the Liquor Authority in terms of sub delegated authority.

### 5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008, as amended by the Western Cape Liquor Amendment Act, 2010 and Western Cape Liquor Regulations, 2011 were implemented on 1 April 2012. In terms of the Act, the City Manager must comment on applications for liquor licences in terms of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008, as amended.

The City Manager ruled that all liquor licenses received within the City from the various Designated Liquor Officers be received at a central venue.

The City Manager has delegated his authority to the Subcouncil, Where time or legal constraints do not allow the timeous submission of the matter to the Subcouncil, the Subcouncil Manager, in conjunction with the chairperson and relevant ward councillor, has the sub-delegated authority to deal with the matter.

#### 6. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

It be **NOTED** that an application for a liquor licence received from STELLSKI was considered in terms of sub-delegated authority and that the following recommendation was forwarded to the Liquor Authority in terms of the Western Cape

SubCouncil 16 recommends that the application for a Consumption ON and OFF Premises Liquor Licence, reference no. LLA23010003, for the business Stellski BE CONDITIONALLY SUPPORTED:

Subject to the premises being accessible for inspections to be conducted by the City Health, City Emergency Services and Law Enforcement.

### 7. DISCUSSION

### 7.1 Constitutional and Policy Implications

The Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008, as amended by the Western Cape Liquor Amendment Act, 2010 and Western Cape Liquor Regulations, 2011 were

implemented on 1 April 2012. The Act was implemented in phases. In terms of the Act, certain obligations were put on the City Manager. The City Manager ruled that all applications for liquor licenses received within the City be received at a central venue and delegated his authority to the Manager of Subcouncil to receive such applications from the various Designated Liquor Officers.
