## 5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since late 2019 the City has held numerous engagements with interested and affected parties regarding deteriorating water quality in the Milnerton Lagoon. Various sources of pollution have been identified, and a number of interventions are either in planning or currently underway to address these.

DISCUSSION/CONTENTS						
The early part of 2020 saw very poor water quality results along the Diep River and into the Milnerton Lagoon. Areas of concern along the Diep River include the river downstream of the Dunoon informal settlement, the river downstream of Potsdam WWTW and the Theo Marais canal which drains the Montague industrial area. Further down, the river becomes known as Milnerton Lagoon. This section has poor water quality due to the aforementioned flow contributions as well as other local sources such as the contamination from the Joe Slovo settlement which enters the lagoon via a stormwater outlet.						
Causes of pollution in Diep River and Milnerton Lagoon include:						
<ul> <li>□ Technical problems experienced at the Potsdam WWTW, specifically with the dewatering process and Ultra-Violet disinfection facility.</li> <li>□ Higher concentrations of nutrients in the wastewater entering the plant due to the drought.</li> <li>□ Pump station overflows and sewer overflows due to extent to which lines are being blocked with foreign objects such as rags.</li> </ul>						
□ Informal development, including land invasions.  Measures to address these issues from the Water and Waste directorate are described in Annexure A, for the Month of July 2021.
