5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is for the health facilities within the boundaries of sub council 4 for the period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021. The report covers both Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) and Environmental Health Services (EH). Overall the facilities are doing well and are meeting most of its targets (detailed performance report available on request).

7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

City Health Department is responsible for two main focus areas of service delivery namely; Environmental Health Services (EH) which delivered from Bellville and Parow EH Offices and Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) at Adriaanse, Dirkie Uys, Elsies River, Parow, Ravensmead and Uitsig clinics and an outpatient Alcohol & Substance Abuse Program at Delft South Clinic. The performance of each unit is presented below as measured against specific set Service Delivery Budget Implementation Plan (SDBIP) targets.

7.1 PERSONAL PRIMARY HEALTH CARE

This part of the report highlights performance of the clinics in relation to the SDBIP, focusing on key indicators namely reduction of HIV/AIDS/STI and TB, reduction of death rate for children under 5 years, antenatal care, women's health and teenage pregnancy. Adriaanse, Uitsig and Ravensmead clinics deliver ARV services and Adriaanse the additional service of non-communicable diseases (management of diabetes and hypertension).

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), Acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), and Tuberculosis (TB) & Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Programme:

This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing the aforementioned diseases and related deaths. For the period under review, performance for this programme is as follows: -

Comments and remedial actions:

As a result of the reorganization of services as a measure to mitigate the risks of COVID-19, HIV Testing decreased at our health facilities. Facilities could also not do outreaches to factories, schools and malls, further impacting HIV Testing.

Due to the reduced number of HIV testing, New ART clients enrolled on Antiretroviral Treatment has proportionately been impacted i.e. Reduced HIV testing has result in a decrease in the Positivity Rates, thereby a reduction in new ART clients commencing on Antiretroviral Treatment.

We will continue to offer HIV Tests to all eligible clients. Adherence counselling of ART clients will be further strengthened. The club system will be utilized to integrate clinical services with pharmacy services. Continue to recall defaulters using the appointment system.

Child and Youth Health

Programmes under child health and youth health are aimed at preventing and reducing childhood and youth diseases as well as deaths related to such diseases. Child and Youth Health programmes performance are as follows: -

Comments and remedial actions:

Patients do not attend the primary healthcare facilities due to the reorganization of services to mitigate the risks of COVID-19. Health promotion activities at schools have been halted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Remedial actions include the recalling of immunization defaulters using the appointment system and PREHMIS (web-based patient administration system). No missed opportunities in the facility and doing daily talks in the facility to improve uptake of immunization.

Women's Health

Women's Health is one of the priority programmes that the City monitors very closely. This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing disease and deaths of women as result of cancer, child birth etc. For the period under review, performance for this programme is as follows: -

Comments and remedial actions:

As a result of the reorganization of services in facilities to mitigate the risks of COVID-19 all women's health programmes were impacted due to the reduced visits to our facilities.

Our outreach services to business premises for distribution of female condoms and cervical smears could not be done due to the current pandemic.

Remedial actions include follow up on capturing of data by facility managers, daily talks to encourage early bookings and booking of clients on first presentation at facility – no missed opportunities.

Alcohol & Substance Abuse Program (Transversal):

Interpersonal violence as a result of amongst others alcohol and substance abuse is a number one cause of death in Tygerberg. The programme is aimed at prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of the addicts and support to their families. For the period under review, performance for this programme is as follows: -

Food Hygiene and Safety

On a regular basis, environmental health practitioners (EHPs) take food samples from various outlets/businesses to monitor food hygiene and safety. These samples included food products, bacteriological swabs from the hands of food handlers and surfaces where food products are prepared.

The necessary remedial actions were taken in all cases of non-compliance which included written notices to owners and managers of restaurants and butcheries. For the period under review, performance for this indicator is as follows: -
