3. **PURPOSE**

To revise the sector and / or seat composition of ward committees in Ward 4 of Subcouncil 3.

4. **FOR DECISION BY**

Subcouncil 3

Council on 27 January 2022, vide (C23/01/22) approved the continuous use of the Rules for the Election and Establishment of Ward Committees. In terms of Clause 3.2 of the aforementioned Rules, the Subcouncil is hereby authorised to establish and determine the composition of ward committees for their area of jurisdiction.

5. **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

At its inaugural meeting held on 18 November 2021, Council approved the type of municipality for the City of Cape Town to be one with a Mayoral Executive System combined with both a Subcouncil and Ward Participatory System.

To give effect to this form of government structure, Council also approved the continuous use of the Rules for the Election and Establishment of Ward Committees for the City of Cape Town as adopted by Council on 22 January 2022 (C23/02/22).

In terms of Clause 3.2 of the aforementioned Rules the Subcouncil has the authority to establish and determine the composition of ward committees within its boundaries of operation. This determination is to be preceded by a recommendation from the respective ward councillors at a Subcouncil meeting.

In terms of rule 9 of the Rules for the Election and Establishment of Ward Committees for the City of Cape Town: Should a request be received from a Ward Councillor that the Subcouncil should add, subtract or combine a sector(s) to be represented on a specific ward committee, the Subcouncil Manager in consultation with the Subcouncil Chairperson must determine the date on which the Subcouncil shall consider the request and inform the members of the affected ward committee of that Subcouncil meeting and its purpose and request their comments for submission to the Subcouncil at its meeting.
