The City recently underwent restructuring and divided its jurisdictional boundaries along ODTP areas. Area North, for purposes of Metropolitan Police Department reporting, is embraced within Sub Councils 1-7. This report presents a statistical overview for a single Sub Council and divided into various themes. It ranges from crime: detailing arrests, patrols, confiscations to traffic fines and DWI arrests. It also includes bylaw offences encountered during both routine patrols and dedicated operations. In terms of Section 7 of the Regulations for Municipal Police Services, Government Gazette Notice No. 20142, which states: "(1) The Executive Head must, at the end of each quarter of the financial year of the municipal council concerned, in writing submit a report concerning the functioning of the Municipal Police Service and the implementation of the plan contemplated in Section 64C (2) (g) to the Committee referred to in Section 64J (2). A copy of the report contemplated in Sub Regulation (1) must be forwarded to the member of the Executive Council and the Provincial Commissioner concerned.

Moreover, the Executive Head *ex officio* Chief of Metropolitan Police devolved and cascaded the submission requirements to Sub Councils as well. Meaning Area Heads, in light of the recent organisational restructuring, are to submit the same quarterly report to their legislative constituents and local oversight bodies such as Sub Councils.


