

7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

The City recently underwent restructuring and divided its jurisdictional boundaries along ODTF areas. Area North, for purposes of Metropolitan Police Department reporting, is embraced within Sub Councils 1-7. This report presents a statistical overview for a single Sub Council and divided into various themes. It ranges from crime: detailing arrests, patrols, confiscations to traffic fines and DWI arrests. It also includes bylaw offences encountered during both routine patrols and dedicated operations. The report also speaks to protest actions and any other complaints such as accidents that occurred during the period in question.

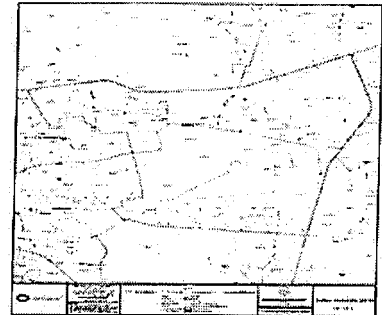
