3. PURPOSE

For the Subcouncil to approve the recommendation for an application for the extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6(1) of the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013.

4. FOR DECISION BY

Subcouncil in terms of Delegation 4(2)

To approve, refuse or vary applications for extension of trading days and hours on premises where liquor licences have been granted in terms of Section 2 of the Bylaw: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public, 2013.

5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013, was promulgated on 17 January and coming into effect on 01 February 2014

An application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law was submitted to the Health Directorate and circulated to the relevant departments for comment.

The fully signed application, including all required comments was submitted to the Subcouncil 3 Manager, and was then circulated to abutting neighbours, all organisations included on the **Ward 107** database and ward committee members for comment.

Clause 9 of the By-law requires that the City must, before approving an application for the extension of trading days and hours, reasonably and fairly consider further factors which must include, inter alia-

- (a) the validity of the liquor licence;
- (b) where applicable, the validity of a business licence issued in terms of the Businesses Act of 1991 (Act No. 71 of 1991);
- (c) location category as per the Schedule:
- (d) previous suspension, amendment or revocation of extended trading days and hours including previous records of complaints investigated and confirmed in respect of the last twelve months preceding a current application for extension;
- (e) the proximity of the licensed premises to surrounding residential zoned area, cultural, religious and educational facilities;
- (f) outcome of community consultation and the recommendation of the relevant ward:
- (g) the potential impact on the surrounding environment;
- (h) whether it is in the public interest to approve and grant an extension of trading days or hours; or
- (i) a motivation from the applicant dealing with the impact of -
 - (i) the risks to and nuisances on the surrounding community;
 - (ii) mitigation measures to assist the control of risks and nuisances; and
 - (iii) possible benefits of extended liquor trading hours and days on the surrounding community.
- (j) The basis and rationale behind all decision-making must be recorded.

6. DISCUSSION

- 6.1 Section 6 (1) of the By-Law reads as follows:
 - 6(1) Subject to subsection (5), (6) and (7) a licensee may upon payment of the required fee, submit a written application to the City to extend the liquor trading days and hours of licensed premises.
- 6.2 The following application for extension of liquor trading hours in terms of Section 6 (1) of the By-law has been received by the Subcouncil:

After having considered every objection as well as the comments from the City's Liquor Unit and SAPS, I would like to recommend that Subcouncil 3 approve the application for extended trading hours, subject to the imposition of the following condition:

- Extended trading hours (02h00 – 04h00) for on-consumption on Fridays, Saturdays and Public Holidays only.

The City deals with an enormous amount of noise nuisance complaints. Ward 107 had 31 separate complaints for the month of January 2019 for noise nuisance alone. Whilst one establishment may not be the cause on their own, combined there is unfortunately noise nuisance that surrounding residents have to deal with. In order to remain fair to the establishments and patrons as well as to those residents who have to endure the noise nuisance, I feel this would be the best solution. This has already been implemented at establishments in the surrounding area.

 - Pertaining to the mentioned premises namely, News Café Table View, situated at 1 Beach Boulevard, Table View. It was ascertained that the applicant did renew his Liquor Licence for 2019. Complaints were received regarding the establishment trading outside their permitted times where a spot fine was issued on the 24th of March 2018 for trading hours, as well as a spot fine for not having a business licence for a live DJ, which is in contravention with the City's By-Laws on the 12th of May 2018. Another spot fine was issued for failure to maintain a fire extinguisher. This application is recommended by the South African Police Services.

7. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Subcouncil **consider** the application for the renewal of extended trading hours (on-consumption) Monday to Thursday 11:00 to 02:00 and Fridays, Saturdays and Public Holidays 11:00 to 04:00 submitted by News Café, Table View situated at No 1 Beach Boulevard, Table View, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That the application for the renewal of extended trading hours (onconsumption) submitted by News Café, Table View situated at No 1 Beach Boulevard, Table View, **be considered** as it complies with the criteria included in the City of Cape Town: Control of Undertakings that Sell Liquor to the Public By-Law, 2013.
- (b) Should complaints be received concerning noise and/or unruly behaviour of patrons, these complaints will be investigated and may result in the extended trading hours being withdrawn and will also be referred to the Western Cape Liquor Authority which may jeopardise the renewal of the liquor licence.

- (c) The applicant must ensure that no sale of liquor is made directly to or via a third party to unemployed and/or homeless persons occupying public open spaces in the vicinity of News Café, Table View situated at No 1 Beach Boulevard, Table View.
- (d) This application is also subject to compliance with all relevant by-laws of the City of Cape Town.
- (e) This application will be valid for 12 months from the date of the decision subject to the possession of a valid liquor licence.

As a resident I often hear motor vehicle accidents, tyres screeching and races happening along Blaauwberg & the R27 roads, it is a sad state which SAPS in the area are currently unable to police.

The last 4 years of crime statistics show that there has been an increase in drunk driving cases, and these are only the cases reported (and people caught)

Good evening Yolande,

Thank you for bringing the objections to my attention. I read through all of the objections in detail and don't believe that any legal evidence was raised that would provide substantial reason for rejecting my application. As a result, I have decided to respond in person and not seek legal assistance at this point. I greatly empathise with all residents who live in the vicinity of Marine circle, especially the families with younger kids. I too lived just off Marine Circle, In Coral road, when I got married in 2007 and have first-hand experience of all the complaints raised. The struggle is real and all the points raised carry merit. The evolution of the area predates me and I'm not able to comment on what it was like in the 80's but urbanization is a natural occurrence worldwide and the problems is not unique to Marine Circle.

I am however, now on the other side of the coin and run a business in the area, serving a certain demand from our community. For the past 6 years I have invested substantial funds into growing this side of our business (We've been trading till 04h00 since 2013) and as a result, achieved significant growth in the business. This lead to an increase in our staff compliment of 33%, addressing one of the biggest problems of our country, unemployment. We have owned the store for more than a decade and focused on this area of our business, as we saw a demand for it. This demand was identified as it was an existing demand in the area. We made a calculated decision based on the facts we had at our disposal. We have all the required licenses in place, which are required to run our kind of business and try very hard every day to be a part of the solution, not the problem. The reality is that we run a good business. We are considerate of the residents in the area and if we don't serve this demand someone else will, and they might not be as considerate as us. This suggests that the proposed solution wouldn't address the problem at hand.

The last point that I would like to raise is that there has been an influx of residents, specifically in the Blouberg area, from other provinces and based on the population density and traffic increase of the "semigration", an increase in noise levels is inevitable and cannot be attributed to News Café alone. In fact, it becomes more necessary to provide the service to the public as a result of increased residents. It would still be in the public interest for such a license to be provided as an acceptable food, beverage and entertainment premises to its patrons.

I will leave it there and allow you to follow the correct democratic process to come to a resolve.
