

Motion in terms of rule 18 of the rules of order for Council for the scheduled council meeting on 28 May 2022.

Khayelitsha is a township designed under apartheid spatial planning system. It still has infrastructure, which is inferior for its population growth and dynamics.

Today, Khayelitsha due to its size requires a sewerage infrastructure that is capable of handling the sewerage quantities generated by its townships in order to avoid repeated sewerage blockages.

There is a sewer pump station situated behind RR informal Settlement, utilized by or connected to Wards 18, 87, 89 and 90, which has been impacted heavily by the population growth of the mentioned wards, but not limited to them, it is unable to handle the sewerage outputs from the said wards.

I, Councilor Khayaletu Gxasheka seconded by Councilor Thando Mpengezi move this motion. That Council agree to the following:

- a) That the relevant line department makes resources available to upgrade this sewer pump station to mitigate the sewer blockages as a result of overloading due to the pump station size and population growth.
- b) That the pump station be secured to avoid vandalism and theft of equipment of the pump station
