It was **RESOLVED** that the resolutions taken by the Subcouncil Manager (or acting Subcouncil Manager) in terms of delegated authority during the official recess period of Council of the City of Cape Town **BE NOTED** and **CONFIRMED** that in terms of

- (a) Delegation 24 (2)(1) on the proposed projects to be funded by the Subcouncil 15 Project Budget the Subcouncil Manager resolved that:
 - Subcouncil 15 SUPPORTED the proposed operational projects to be funded against the R1.9 million allocated to the Subcouncil;
 - A monthly progress report be submitted to the Subcouncil on progress made with regard to the implementation of these projects;
 - (iii) Having due regard to the current health situation, the potential financial implications and due to possible time constraints to the execution of these operational projects the Subcouncil Manager, in consultation with the Subcouncil Chairperson and the relevant Ward Councillor(s), BE MANDATED to cancel projects, reallocate funding and amend project name and scopes, on the basis that these cannot stand over to one of the approved Subcouncil Meetings, and that such be reported to the ensuing Subcouncil Meeting for information.
