The Informal Trading By-Law creates the regulatory framework for the management of informal trading within the City of Cape Town. The Informal Trading By-law makes provision for the demarcation of Informal Trading Bays by means of an Informal Trading Plan.

Ward 14	 Draft Informal Trading Plan for Ward 14 is in the process of being finalized in consultation with the Ward Councillor. A request for 3 – 4 trading bays at the Welmoed Cemetery is currently being investigated. The draft trading plan will be completed by 30 November 2019 It is then expected that the formal Public Participation Process for the draft Informal Trading Plan will be conducted in January / February 2020.
