This report is for the health facilities within the boundaries of subcouncil 6 for the period 1 July 2018 to 31 December 2018. The report covers both Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) and Environmental Health Services (EH). Overall the facilities are doing well and are meeting most of its targets (detailed performance report available on request).

7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

City Health Department is responsible for two main focus areas of service delivery namely; Personal Primary Health Care (PPHC) which includes, Kasselsvlei Clinic, Parow Clinic and St Vincent CDC as well as Environmental Health Services (EH). The performance of each unit is presented below as measured against specific set SDBIP targets.

7.1 PERSONAL PRIMARY HEALTH CARE

This part of the report highlights performance of the clinics in relation to the SDBIP, focusing on key indicators namely reduction of HIV, AIDS, TB & Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI), reduction of death rate for children under 5 years, antenatal care & feenage pregnancy.

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), Acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), and Tuberculosis (TB) & Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Programme:

This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing the aforementioned diseases and related deaths. For the period under review performance for this programme is as follows: -

Subcouncil 6 primary health care facilities met the targets for the percentage of HIV positive TB patients commenced on anti-retroviral treatment and number of male condoms distributed (except St. Vincent CDC). However, the target for all clients tested for HIV and the number of new clients enrolled on anti-retroviral treatment was not met.

Child and Youth Health

Programmes under child health and youth health are aimed at preventing and reducing childhood and youth diseases as well as deaths related to such diseases. Child and youth health programmes performance are as follows: -

Subcouncil 6 primary health care facilities did met the targets for the percentage immunisation coverage from hexavalent 1st dose to fully immunised (except St Vincent CDC) and the number of reproductive health clients under 18 years but the targets for percentage preschools visited and number of visits to schools for health promotion outreach programmes were exceeded.

Women's Health

Women's Health is one of the priority programmes that the City monitors very closely. This programme is aimed at preventing and reducing disease and deaths of women as result of cancer, child birth etc.

Subcouncil 6 primary health care facilities did not meet the target for number of cervical smear coverage. Good news is that pregnant women are booking early before 20 weeks to ensure safety of the mother and the unborn child i.e. the target for percentage of antenatal 1st visit before 20 weeks was met (except St. Vincent CDC).

7.2 ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

This part of the report covers the performance of Environmental Health Services on key SDBIP indicators.

Informal Settlements

Once a week environmental health practitioners (EHP) visit every informal settlement to monitor conditions. For the period under review the EHP's have done 338 visits against the target of 329 i.e. target exceeded for the reporting period and health and hygiene projects in informal settlements target was exceeded.

All (100%) of the samples tested were compliant with the quality standards, thus exceeding the target of 99% for the subdistrict. These samples are taken at strategic points linked to the end users.

Vectors are responsible for carrying various illnesses from one place to the other, therefore their control and management is important. The target for number of black baiting stations serviced for controlling rats was not met.

Food Hygiene and Safety

On regular basis, environmental health practitioners (EHPs) take food samples from various outlets/businesses to monitor food hygiene and safety. These samples included food products, bacteriological swabs from the hands of food handlers and surfaces where food products are prepared. The target percentage food samples complying with relevant legislation standards was exceeded and the necessary remedial

actions were taken in all cases of non-compliance which included written notices to owners and managers of restaurants and butcheries.

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Pre-School visits

A total of 400 (100%) pre-schools were visited during the reporting period in order to ensure compliance to the relevant environmental health standards for child care centers. Monitoring of these facilities include health and safety aspects referred to in terms of the Early Childhood Policy of the City of Cape Town and the Regulations Governing General Hygiene Requirements and the Transport of Food.
