3. PURPOSE

This report seeks endorsement of the Cape Town Spatial Development Framework (CTSDF) in terms of the Municipal Systems Act (No. 32 of 2000) (MSA) and approval of a recommendation that the CTSDF be submitted to the competent authority for approval in terms of Section 4(6) of the Land Use Planning Ordinance (No. 15 of 1985) (LUPO). It is also requested that the competent authority withdraw outdated structure plans/ guideplans and down grade the status of some existing plans upon approval of the CTSDF.

5. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The CTSDF (see Annexure 1) is the City's long-term plan for managing Cape Town's spatial growth and change. It aligns the City's spatial development goals, strategies and policies with relevant national and provincial spatial policies. The CTSDF provides the spatial component of the City Development Strategy (forthcoming) and Integrated Development Plan (IDP) and guides the proposals contained in the eight more detailed integrated District Spatial Development Plans/ Environmental Management Frameworks (SDP/EMFs). The CTSDF identifies the areas not suited to development and the areas where the impacts of development need to be managed. It also provides policy guidance to direct decision making on the nature, form, scale and location of urban development.

The CTSDF was advertised for the final round of comments between 1st November and 31st January 2011. This is the final draft of CTSDF and incorporates the comments submitted by the public, other government departments, state owned enterprises, sub-councils (see Annexures 2 & 3) and City departments. The CTSDF has to be approved by Council as part of the Integrated Development Plan in terms of the Municipal Systems Act (Act 32 of 2000) (MSA) and by the Provincial Government: Western Cape (PG:WC) in terms of Section 4(6) of the Land Use Planning Ordinance (No 15 of 1985) (LUPO). The approved CTSDF will in turn allow the City to apply for the withdrawal of outdated Guide Plans/ Urban Structure Plans and structure plans with statutory status, the most significant of which date to 1988 and which still govern land use management decision-making in Cape Town.

7. DISCUSSION/CONTENTS

7.1. Background and process

In 2005 the City reviewed the successes and failures of the Metropolitan Spatial Development Framework (MSDF) and identified the development trends in the city. In 2006 it embarked on a process of preparing an updated city-wide spatial development framework and the development of more detailed, medium term integrated spatial development plans/ environmental management frameworks (SDP/EMF's) for each of the 8 planning districts of the City. It also consulted the public on the development issues facing Cape Town and the goals and principles that should guide the preparation of the CTSDF.

The Planning and Environment Portfolio Committee set up a CTSDF and District SDP/ EMF Task Team to oversee the preparation of these plans.

Draft 1 of the CTSDF was endorsed by PEPCO in July 2009 and the second phase of the public participation process was initiated in August 2009. The public participation process comprised of 7 citywide and 17 district level workshops and 25 sub-council open houses. Upon request of the public, the closing date for comments was extended from 31st October 2009 to 30th November 2009.

The Draft 2 CTSDF incorporated the comments received from the public, state owned enterprises and other spheres of government. It was circulated to the relevant Departments within the City for comment. The Draft 3 CTSDF including the comments received on the Draft 2 CTSDF was submitted to PGWC for provisional inspection.

The Expert Review Panel appointed by the City commented on the Draft 2 CTSDF and a preliminary version of the Draft 4 CTSDF.

In August 2010 PEPCO agreed to the submission of the Draft 3 CTSDF to PG:WC for provisional inspection in terms of Section 4(5) of LUPO. PG:WC indicated that the Draft 3 Cape Town SDF aligned with legislation and the Provincial Spatial Development Framework. They also expressed their satisfaction with the public participation process followed to date and confirmed that the third and final round of public participation could take place. The PG:WC also confirmed that a 60 day period for the submission of comment and input by the public is sufficient for the third and final round of public participation.

The Draft 4 CTSDF was advertised for the final round of public and external comment between 8th November and 31st January 2011. In addition 5 public workshops and a workshop for external government departments and state owned enterprises were held in November 2011. This draft was also circulated to sub-councils and internal departments for comment during this period and officials attended all the sub-council meetings. On the 27th and 28th January 2011 public hearings were held.

This is the final draft of the CTSDF and incorporates, to the extent that it is possible and appropriate, the comments received through the aforementioned processes. The City's response to comments submitted by the public, other spheres of government and state owned enterprises and Sub-Councils are contained in Annexures 2 and 3 respectively.

On 22nd February 2011 the PEPCO Urban Edge Task Team reviewed the public's requests to reconsider the alignment of the Urban and Coastal Edge in select places. The recommendation of the Task Team are contained in Annexure 4 and are shown on the plans.

7.2. Overview of the CTSDF

7.2.1 Why is the CTSDF important?

The CTSDF will guide the future spatial form and structure of Cape Town (i.e. the way in which we use the available space for urban growth).

In effect, it is a long-term (20⁺-year) plan to manage new growth and change in Cape Town, to ensure that we live in a more sustainable and equitable city. Cape Town should work for all – the young, old, rich and poor.

The plans and policies of the CTSDF will:

- indicate the areas best suited to urban development, the areas that should be protected, and the areas where development may occur if it is sensitively managed;
- provide investors with a clear idea of where they should invest;
- guide public investment in infrastructure and social facilities;
- be used to assess applications submitted by property developers; and
- guide changes in land use rights.

The CTSDF does not give or take away zoning rights.

7.2.2 The long term metropolitan spatial structure

The ideas and spatial building blocks that will put Cape Town on a more sustainable development path, and shape where and how the city grows, include the following:

Resilience and adaptivity: Cape Town's spatial organisation must be flexible in order to be able to respond and adapt to change.

A city within a region: Cape Town's functional interrelationships with neighbouring towns require greater coordination in planning, budgeting, and growth and resource management.

Natural assets: The natural resources (such as the mountains, biodiversity and coastline) that make Cape Town a unique and desirable place to live, should shape where and how the city develops.

The multidirectional accessibility grid: Cape Town's spatial organisation must shift towards a grid-based movement system that facilitates convenient access and multidirectional movement. *Activity routes* and *development routes* are key elements of this grid.

Areas of land use intensification: A diverse mix of land uses should be concentrated in accessible, high-opportunity locations. Areas of land use intensification include *development corridors*, *urban nodes*, *strip development* and *civic precincts*.

Development edges and growth directions: City growth should be managed through *development edges*, which contain sprawl and protect natural, heritage and urban areas. Identified *growth directions* will serve to guide urban expansion in the medium to longer term.

Destination places: Landmarks or locations that are significant points of attraction, and form part of Cape Town's unique identity, should be preserved and new destinations developed, particularly in underserved or neglected areas.

7.2.3 Strategies and policies

Below is a summary of the most important strategies and interventions that will assist in the implementation of the CTSDF. The more detailed sub strategies and policy statements flowing from the key strategies can be found in Chapter 5 of the CTSDF.

Strategy 1: Plan for employment, and improve access to economic opportunities

The interventions that will help achieve this include the following:

- Maintain the assets of Cape Town, such as its infrastructure (airports, road network, etc.), natural environment, universities and other social facilities, which attract investors, visitors and high-skilled labour
- Help small and large formal businesses as well as informal business to set up and trade in appropriate locations, by facilitating their access to information and land, and by simplifying application procedures
- Reduce the distance between where people live and work, especially for those in the metropolitan southeast (Khayelitsha, Mitchells Plain, Philippi, Gugulethu, etc.) and Atlantis
- Support the development of a good public transport system that conveniently takes people to wherever they live, work and play
- Encourage shops, businesses, higher-density residential development and industries to locate on routes well served by public transport, namely activity and development routes, so that people can reach them more easily

Strategy 2: Manage urban growth, and create a balance between urban development and environmental protection

The following more specific interventions are proposed:

- Ensure that the spatial development of Cape Town takes place in a planned and efficient way
- Plan and manage development in a way that makes responsible use of resources
- Minimise the negative environmental impacts of new development in the city
- Carefully manage urban development in areas that could put people in danger or affect quality of life, for example areas too close to airports and Koeberg Nuclear Power Station
- Encourage more intense use of land across the city, and allow higher densities in areas with good public transport, at concentrations of employment, commercial development and/or social facilities as well as in areas of high amenity
- Use an urban edge to reduce urban sprawl and protect natural, cultural and heritage assets
- Use a coastal edge to conserve coastal processes and protect residents from the possible impacts of climate change, such as sea-level rise
- Support development approaches that allow the incremental (step-by-step) improvement of living environments of the poor over time
- Protect the city's rural and farming land from urban development

Strategy 3: Build an inclusive, integrated, vibrant city

Actions that will help build a vibrant city, where people have more equal access to the city's amenities and opportunities, include the following:

- Transform the apartheid city by encouraging a better mix of people and land uses in neighbourhoods
- Identify land for subsidised and other forms of affordable housing in order to help create opportunities for housing delivery

- Encourage the effective use of publicly owned land
- Guide the City's budget and decision making to ensure that all communities have access to an adequate and broadly similar range of social facilities, open spaces and public institutions
- Enhance the value of the diverse cultural assets and heritage that Cape Town offers
- Create more great people places that are easy to reach and can be enjoyed by all. Existing examples of such places are Kalk Bay and Kirstenbosch. New great people places could be developed on the Athlone power station site, in the False Bay and Silwerstroomstrand coastal nodes and Durbanville winelands.

7.2.4 The Spatial Development Framework

In order to replace the Guide Plans, the CTSDF is required to be of a similar level of detail and provide spatial direction to guide future city growth and development. The land uses depicted on the composite plan (see Chapter 6 & Map 6.1) are therefore intentionally broad in order to reduce unnecessary amendments and retain flexibility within the parameters of the established spatial framework. More detailed guidance will be provided by District SDP/ EMF's and local area planning frameworks approved at an appropriate statutory status.

Map 6.1 has been generated on a geographic information system (GIS). It is anticipated that this will reduce the need for consistency rulings (further explained in Chapter 1 of the CTSDF).

7.2.5 The way forward

To ensure the practical application of the spatial building blocks, strategies and policies of the CTSDF, a multifaceted implementation strategy, which includes the following elements, is required:

- A more responsive and flexible policy driven land use management system needs to be put in place
- The implementation of the CTSDF needs to be monitored and it needs to be reviewed from time to time.
- A 15-year growth management plan that provides a medium-term link between the long-term City Development Strategy and the 5-year Integrated Development Plan and aligns sectoral master plans and strategic and asset maintenance investment priorities needs to be put in place.

7.3 Legal Implications

The preparation of the CTSDF is required by and is taking place within the Municipal Systems Act (No 31 of 2000) (MSA), Land Use Planning Ordinance (No 15 of 1985) (LUPO), and Development Facilitation Act (No 108 of 1996). In order to replace the outdated guide plans the CTSDF must be approved in terms of the MSA and LUPO.

In terms of this legislation, the City is required to elicit public comment on the CTSDF before it is approved as a policy. This provision has been complied with (see Sections 7.1).

7.6 Other Services Consulted

An Inter-Departmental Steering Committee, which also includes PG:WC representatives was set up to facilitate participation in the drafting of the CTSDF and eight integrated District SDPs. It has, to date, met 7 times. These meetings have included presentations on the development issues facing Cape Town, the CTSDF goals, spatial principles, spatial structuring elements, strategies and policies. In addition, bilateral consultations have been undertaken with relevant departments in the City. Bi-laterals have also been held with ACSA, ESKOM, the National Energy Regulator (NNR), Transnet, PRASA, PG:WC Department of Education and National Department of Correctional Services.

In November 2010 all relevant departments were asked to comment on the Draft 4 CTSDF and the CTSDF presentations was offered to all departments. Written comments were received from the following departments: Housing; Planning and Building Development Management; Economic Development; Tourism; Environmental Resource Management; Transport; Roads and Stormwater. and Water and Sanitation. The comments received have, to the extent that it is possible, been incorporated into the attached CTSDF.
